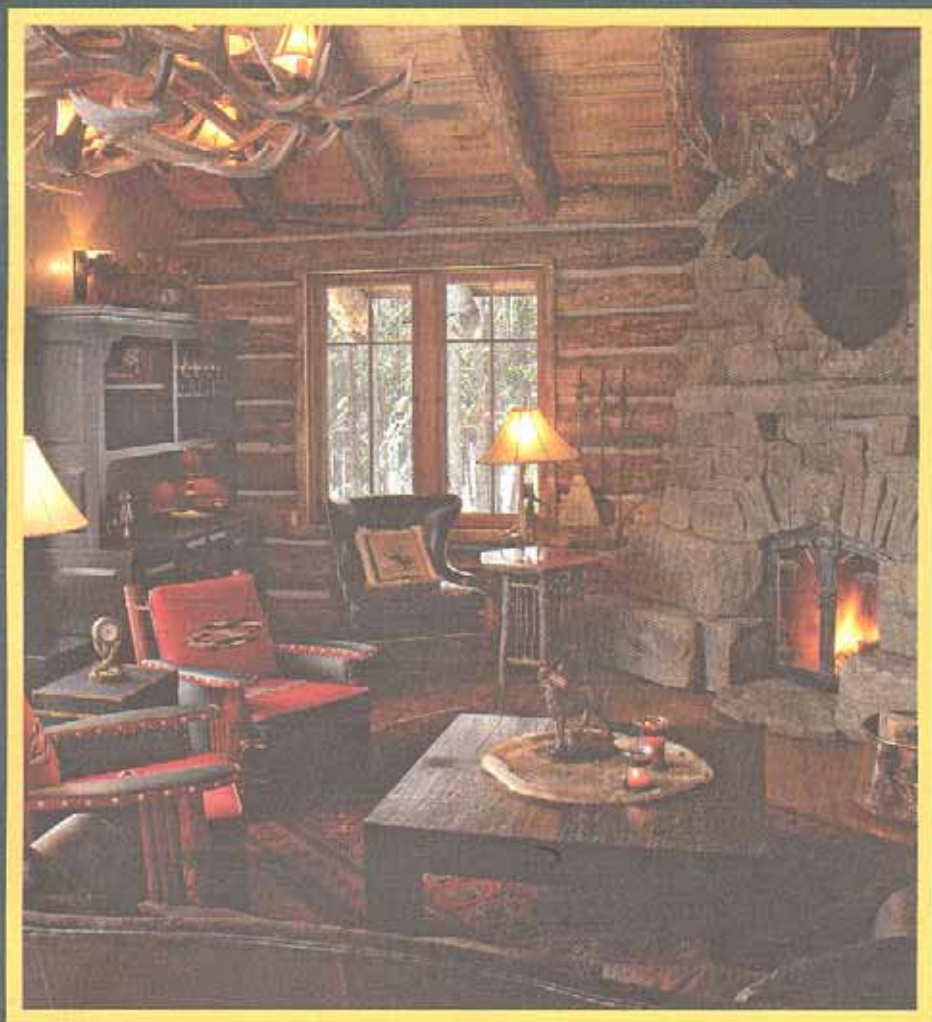

LUDLOW'S ISLAND

This enclave of 15 cabins dotting a lovely little island in Lake Vermilion has inspired many of the cabins I've written about over the years and many of the designs I've applied to other cabins.

The island is, in fact (albeit unintentionally), a kind of cabin laboratory, with old cabins and new cabins, cabins built with local timber and out of discarded doors, one-story cabins and two-story cabins, and even a four-story tower cabin that the students in one of my architecture classes conceived and designed.

What Ludlow's cabins have in common is their setting in the Land of Sky Blue Waters—a little slice of paradise on the lake. And even the magic of the final boat ride to the island solidifies our escape from that “other” world into the bucolic realm of sunfish, sunsets, and s'mores.
